THE AUTHOR

Well past the three-score years and ten scholar and educationist, Professor D. S. Sarma was educated at the Madras Christian College where he took his M.A. Degree in English Language and Literature in 1909. Starting life in Government service at the Kumbakonam College, he went over to the Presidency College, Madras, in 1913 where he remained on the English staff for twenty-two years. After a short spell of service as the Principal of the Government College, Rajahmundry, he retired from Government service in 1938. He has since been the Principal of Pachaiyappa's College, Madras, and Vivekananda College run by Sri Ramakrishna Mission, Madras.

He has a number of books on Hinduism to his credit. Notable among them is his English translation of the 'Gita' which has gone into seven editions. Among his other books may be mentioned 'The Tales and Teachings of Hinduism', 'A Primer of Hinduism', 'What is Hinduism', 'The Renaissance of Hinduism', 'The Prince of Ayodhya', 'Introduction to the Bhagavad Gita', 'Lectures and Essays on Gita', 'Lalita Sahasranama', 'Gandhi Sutras', etc.
