BIRTH CONTROL

"Birth Control by contraceptives, no doubt regulates to a certain extent the number of new comers and enables persons of moderate means to keep the wolf from the door. But the moral harm it does to the individual and society is incalculable. For one thing, the outlook upon life for those who satisfy the sexual appetite for the sake of it, is wholly changed. Marriage ceases to be a sacrament for them. It means a revaluation of the social ideals hitherto prized as precious treasure.

My argument is only addressed to those who regard marriage as a sacrament and woman not as an instrument of animal pleasure, but as mother of man and trustee of the virtue of her progeny"
