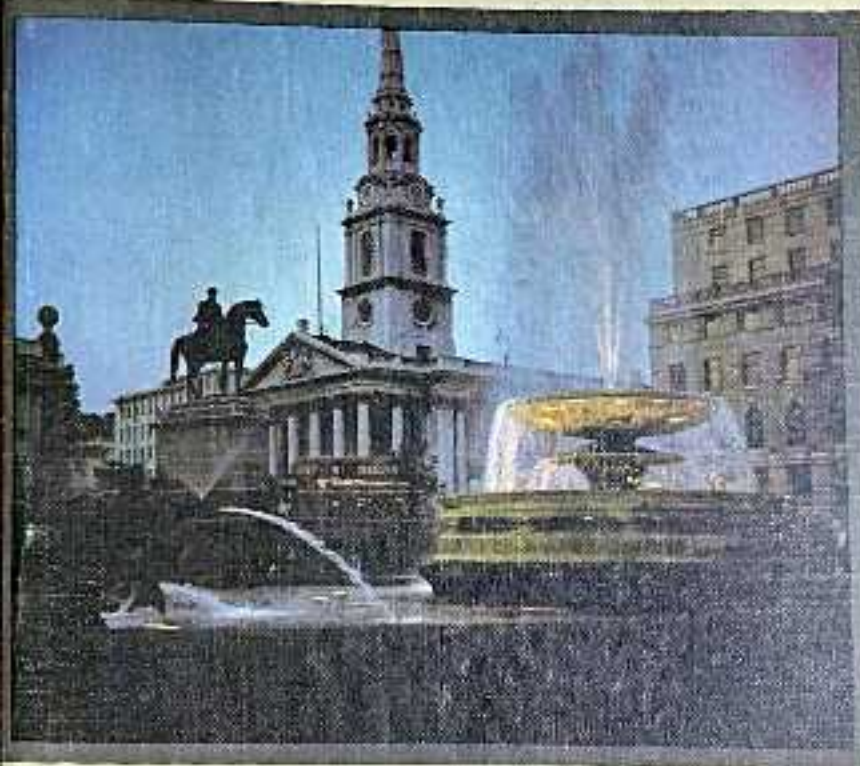

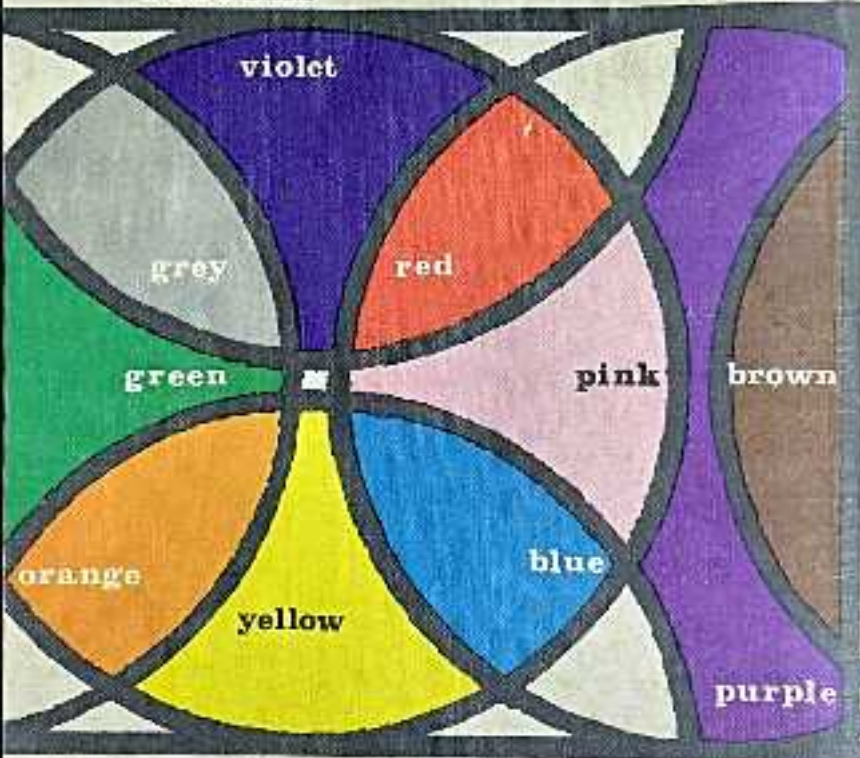
This is a reference book for students who are at an intermediate stage of learning English, and who need to extend their vocabulary before they can practise their English effectively, either in school subjects or in business and social life.

Part I (Glossary) contains approximately 4,000 head-words, with definitions, examples of current usage and references to the pictures.

Part II (Pictorial Section) consists of 72 pages of illustrations of some 1,400 familiar objects arranged under topics such as 'Anatomy', 'Social Services', 'Clothes to Wear' etc., with a word list on each page numbered for cross-references to the Glossary.

As a 'companion' in reading and listening, this book will enable the student to discover the chief meanings and idiomatic usage of the words selected.
