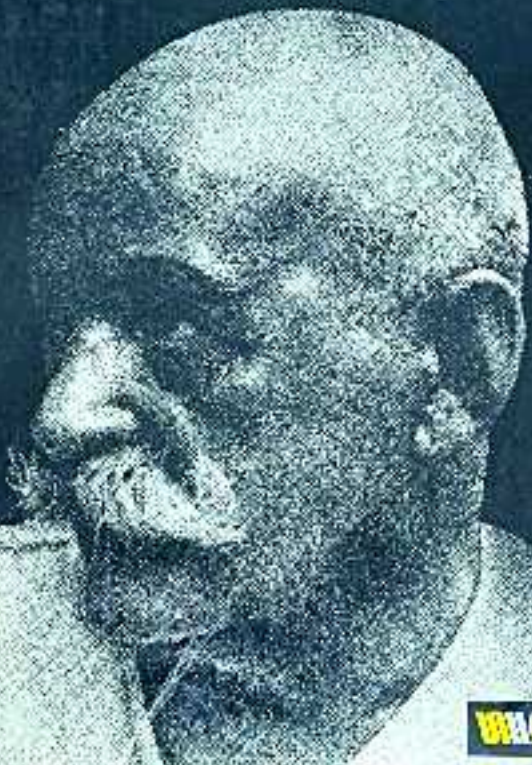


# GURDJIEFF

For more than forty years Kenneth Walker studied the work of Gurdjieff, first with Ouspensky and then with Gurdjieff himself. He followed Gurdjieff's advice of 'Take the understanding of the East and the knowledge of the West and then work' and related Gurdjieff's teaching to Western science and mysticism on the one hand and Eastern disciplines on the other. Gurdjieff's concept of man as a self-developing organism embraced many threads, from Gita, Vedanta and Tao, as well as from Sufi and Christian beliefs.

Kenneth Walker provides a book of clear insights written in a compelling and simple way. He was a man of two worlds, of medicine, in which he was a distinguished surgeon, and of philosophy and esoteric religion. He died in 1966.
