THE AUTHOR

M. Yamunacharya, born in the closing year of the 19th century, has had the proud privilege of studentship under Dr. S. Radhakrishnan and Professors A. R. Wadia and M. Hiriyanna. He imbibed with special earnestness the spiritual teachings of Ramanuja's philosophy from his grandfather and guru, Swami A. Govindacharya, a notable scholar of Visishtadvaita.

Yamunacharya taught philosophy, both Eastern and Western, to the undergraduates and post-graduates of the University of Mysore for nearly thirty years.

Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy and way of life fascinated the author as the years passed and his deep study of this "finest flower of India's spiritual heritage" resulted in his being appointed by the Gandhi Smarak Nidhi as the Chief Editor, Kannada section. He has brought out in Kannada twenty volumes of Gandhiji's writings, in the course of five years.

Comparative philosophy, religion and Gandhian thought have always been the author's main interest. An active member of the Indian Philosophical Congress, he presided over its Ethics and Social Philosophy Section once. He has to his credit many books in Kannada and English, and valuable research papers published in leading academic journals and read before learned bodies like the Indian Philosophical Congress, All-India Oriental Conference, Mythic Society and the Indian Institute of World Culture.
